

LIFE FORCE SINGLE ENGINE PILOT JOB SUMMARY AND QUALIFICATIONS

Job Summary:

The Single Engine VFR Captain for LifeForce is a FAA licensed current and instrument proficient pilot responsible for the operation of LifeForce aircraft. The Single Engine VFR Captain performs a variety of tasks including single-pilot management of a single engine aircraft equipped with state-of-the-art complex navigation systems during day and night, VFR, unpressurized helicopter operations.

Required:

High School Diploma.

Preferred:

Graduate of an Accredited Aviation School or Academy.

Experience:

Required:

- Five (5) years as a pilot in command in single and multiengine turbine powered helicopters.
- One hundred (100) hours of flight time in a Bell 206L series helicopter.

Preferred:

- Three thousand (3,000) hours of flight time as Pilot-In-Command of which two thousand (2,000) must have been in helicopters.
- At least one hundred (100) hours of flight time in complex multiengine aircraft.
- One hundred (100) hours of actual instrument condition flight time.
- Bell 412 experience
